

'Who else would shape the future?!' Your World Your Say Survey Results - Summary, 2010



Your World Your Say

'Your World Your Say' was an online survey run by Global Learning Network South West (GLEAN). Open to all young people age 12-18+, 299 have completed the survey, the majority (75%) age 12-14.

The aim of YWYS is to give young people a voice on global issues and world events, and a chance to express their ideas about their role in 'changing the future for the better' (see QCDA 'Aims of the Curriculum').

It is also to inform the development of 'student voice' methodology, so we can better engage with young people as responsible global citizens who feel empowered to take action to reduce global poverty.

The Survey

We asked how much they knew about global issues such as conflict and human rights, how much these issues matter to them and who they talk to about these issues.

We also asked if they feel young people have a role to play in shaping the future, whether they feel able to lead change in their school or college, and what action they would be willing to take to try to make the world more fair and sustainable.
